Foundation VCE Scholarship



St Paul's Anglican Grammar School is a regional secondary school traditionally attracting students from areas across Gippsland from Pakenham through to Sale. With the expansion of the Traralgon Campus to offer VCE to students in Year 11 in 2026 and Year 12 in 2027, the School is committed to ensuring a diverse school population with representation from as many areas in the region as possible.

As we look forward to our first Year 12 graduates in Traralgon, St Paul's is pleased to offer Foundation VCE Scholarships to **new students for entry in Year 9 in 2024**. Offered under the School's Education Support Program, the Foundation VCE Scholarship will offer places to students continuing through to Year 12 at our **Traralgon Campus**.

The Foundation VCE Scholarship is not based on academic achievement but rather the student's potential to be a dedicated student and an outstanding contributor to their school. Applicants will be shortlisted, with progressing applicants to be interviewed by a representative of St Paul's.

Endorsement for the Foundation VCE Scholarship is based on the degree to which a student meets the following criteria:

- Demonstrates integrity and is of good personal character (including a recommendation from a relevant referee)
- Has a focused approach to their studies and a desire to achieve their potential
- Demonstrates enthusiasm and respect for others
- Shows commitment to their current school and/or community-based activities
- Currently resides in the shires of Latrobe, Wellington or South Gippsland (and able to travel to Traralgon for the purposes of schooling).

Conditions of the Foundation VCE Scholarship:

- a) The student will be enrolled in Year 9 for 2024.
- b) The Scholarship will be continuous from Year 9 to Year 12 at St Paul's Anglican Grammar School's Traralgon Campus.
- c) Remission of the school tuition fee is by negotiation and is strictly confidential. This may include a significantly discounted tuition fee.
- d) The student, nor any member of their family, must not be a current member of the St Paul's school community.

Recipients of the Foundation VCE Scholarship are expected on an annual basis to:

- Maintain a satisfactory level of academic progress
- Consistently model good behaviour and be a positive influence in the School community
- Participate in the various co-curricular activities offered
- Attend class regularly
- Consent to photo permission for individual and/or group photos for school promotion on the School Webpage, the School Facebook site, promotional material and school Publications. (Please contact our Scholarship Officer to discuss should this not be possible)
