A minimum of **four weeks written notice** must be given to the Performing Arts Office if tuition is to be terminated. In addition to the listed charges, an annual administration fee of **\$80**, which includes the provision of the Co-curricular Performing Arts Record Book (sufficient for the entire year), will be billed to your Sundry Fee account. Conditions under which Tuition is available

- 1. Lessons are offered on an individual basis. Group lessons are not available.

- 3. One lesson per week, per area of study is delivered during school hours (unless an alternate time has been formally negotiated). It is the joint responsibility of both parents and students to ensure that any work missed in the classroom is caught up through consultation with the classroom teacher and, if required, to reschedule with 24 hours notice any lesson where there is a conflict regarding compulsory class testing or attendance. Please note that classroom teachers give students more than 24 hours notice regarding any scheduled testing or compulsory class attendance.
- 4. Unless 24 hours notice has been given in respect of absence or illness, tutors will not be required to reschedule a lesson. Lessons missed are still chargeable, however, lessons missed due to tutor absences are re-scheduled by the tutor. In the case of absence or illness, please contact the Performing Arts Office at the earliest possible opportunity by telephoning 5622 6358 (after hours message service available) or via email to: performingartsoffice@stpaulsags.vic.edu.au
- 5. A minimum of **four weeks written notice** must be given to the Performing Arts Office if tuition is to be terminated. A Notice of Termination form is available via the MyStPauls Performing Arts portal page, or the Performing Arts Office.
- 6. Student progress will be subject to assessment and a written report will be provided each semester.
- 7. Each student must undertake regular and consistent practice to obtain the full benefit of the tuition being provided. It is expected that students will participate in the Performing Arts Co-Curricular Ensemble Program. The Cocurricular Performing Arts department seeks the full support of parents and guardians regarding the practice schedule as recommended by a tutor. Generally, a specific amount of practice each day for a minimum of 5 days in any given week is recommended.
- The usefulness of the Co-curricular Performing Arts Record Book is dependent on students bringing the Record Book to all lessons, actively pursuing the program of work as set out in this book and having their parents sign this book every week.
- 9. Junior School students wishing to pursue more than one discipline in this program will need to seek the approval of the Head of School. Advice should be sought from the Performing Arts Office if you have any queries.
- 10. Parents are encouraged to make contact with the tutor and/or the Performing Arts Office if they have any concerns or queries. Any issues arising will be addressed as promptly as possible.

Hire charges are subject to change. If enrolling in or discontinuing lessons after the term commences, one full term's hire fee will apply.

Conditions of Hire

- 1. All reasonable care must be taken against the instrument being lost, stolen or damaged. After an instrument has been issued, it is under the complete care and responsibility of that student until the instrument is returned. Any accessories, such as strings, reeds etc. are to be paid for by the hirer. These can be sourced through the School and added to your Sundry Fee account.
- 2. The hirer must pay for all repairs necessary due to any damage caused through student negligence. Parents and guardians are strongly advised to include the instrument as an addition to household insurance to cover any damage, loss, or theft whilst in your care. On no account may the student, or any other person, attempt repairs or adjustments to the instrument. Any damage or defect in the instrument must be brought to the attention of the tutor or the Performing Arts Office.
- 3. After a reasonable period of time hiring an instrument, families are encouraged to invest in purchasing their own instrument, subject to the prior advice of the instrumental tutor.
