Hire charges are subject to change. If enrolling in or discontinuing lessons after the term commences, one full term's hire fee will apply.

## Conditions of Hire

1. All reasonable care must be taken against the instrument being lost, stolen or damaged. After an instrument has been issued, it is under the complete care and responsibility of that student until the instrument is returned. Any accessories, such as strings, reeds etc. are to be paid for by the hirer. These can be sourced through the School and added to your Sundry Fee account.
2. The hirer must pay for all repairs necessary due to any damage caused through student negligence. Parents and guardians are strongly advised to include the instrument as an addition to household insurance to cover any damage, loss, or theft whilst in your care. On no account may the student, or any other person, attempt repairs or adjustments to the instrument. Any damage or defect in the instrument must be brought to the attention of the tutor or the Performing Arts Office.
3. After a reasonable period of time hiring an instrument, families are encouraged to invest in purchasing their own instrument, subject to the prior advice of the instrumental tutor.

**Please Note:**

*Hired instruments must be returned prior to the last day of term to avoid being charged an additional term's hire. This arrangement is a requirement of the School's external instrument supplier.*
