

2022

New Sports Precinct

Our outdoor basketball courts were relocated and expanded to incorporate four full-size courts, giving our students access to more hardcourt space within our growing secondary school.

2023

New Futures Centre

As the multi-level Futures Centre neared completion, the potential of an independent VCE alternative in the Latrobe Valley moves much closer to reality. Planning for curriculum delivery also commenced, with an expansion of teaching leadership and dedicated focus on planning for the introduction of VCE studies and timetabling. In addition, wellbeing, careers and study skills programs for Years 11 and 12 students are being developed ready for commencement in 2026.

The Futures Centre

The Futures Centre's cutting-edge facilities are ready to be enjoyed by staff, students and families. Students are pleased with the new modern facility, which includes a resourceful library, state-of-the-art performing arts facilities, indoor-to-outdoor cafeteria facilities and wellbeing counselling spaces. Multi-purpose learning and gathering spaces are being utilised for collaborative work and enjoyment.

VCE Subject Selections

A breadth of subjects will be offered by highly professional and experienced teachers, with subjects tailored to student aims. The range



of subjects offered will include all courses that are prerequisites for further study, as well as broader options depending on student interest.

Every year level has its own unique interests and preferences. A range of VCE subjects from Year 10 through to Year 12, as well as vocational pathways will be offered to cater for these preferences.

Outstanding educators will support the learning and academic interests of our most senior students as they complete their secondary schooling.

It is anticipated that the core VCE subject selection for Year 11 in 2026 and Year 12 in 2027 is likely to include (at a minimum):

Based on student and cohort preferences we will endeavour to cater to the most requested subjects for our students in Years 11 and 12.

With St Paul's having two VCE campuses from 2026, there will also be an option for students from Traralgon or Warragul to join alternative subjects online in addition to those offered at their campus. (subject to timetable capacity). Students who wish to study a subject through Virtual Schools Victoria or the Victorian School of Languages will be supported in this alternative.

How soon will VCE be offered at St Paul's Traralgon Secondary School?

VCE subjects already run for Year 10 students across a range of subject areas. We will offer VCE at Year 11 in 2026 and grow to include Year 12 in 2027. Students who commenced Year 7 in 2022 will be our pioneering VCE students at the Traralgon Campus.

Are there any differences in fees or uniform across the campuses?

No, fee levels and uniform will be the same across all campuses.

What specialist facilities will be offered at the Traralgon Campus?

St Paul's commenced construction in 2022 of a new \$9 million 'Futures Centre' as part of a broader \$15 million capital investment in its Traralgon Campus. The Futures Centre will be a striking multi-level building with outstanding performing arts facilities, a modern secondary library adjoining a spacious cafeteria, a community hub and a range of student learning and gathering spaces, both large and small. Following on from the building of the Futures Centre, from 2026 consecutive stages consisting of specialist and general classrooms will be built to cater for the delivery of a high-quality VCE curriculum.

How can I get to school?

Getting to St Paul's is easy from areas serviced by either the Country School Bus network or the PTV system.

The Country School Buses service areas include: Callignee, Cowwarr, Koornalla, Flynn, Glengarry, Gormandale, Tyers, Toongabbie, Traralgon East, Traralgon South, Rosedale, Willung and Willung South.

PTV buses service Moe, Newborough, Morwell, Yinnar, Churchill, Hazelwood North, Ellavale (Traralgon) and Traralgon East.


We will also commence an express private bus from Sale once sufficient enrolments make this service viable.

Will the current bus network from Traralgon to Warragul continue?

The current bus network from Traralgon to Warragul will be phased out from 2025 when Year 11 and Year 12 students are able to access a VCE curriculum at Traralgon.
