Re: 2025 Years 7 to 9 Student Laptop Program

In line with our Secondary School Laptop Policy, every student in Years 7 to 9 will be provided with a laptop computer. This year the School has again partnered with Atturra, a tier one Hewlett Packard vendor. Atturra have obtained guaranteed delivery of the model as outlined below. The laptop will come with all the software necessary for the students' educational program. The laptop also comes with on-site (school campus) support for both hardware and software, including a loan laptop if required.

The benefits of the Year 7 Laptop Program include

- Access to software with a value of over \$2,000 (Microsoft Windows, Microsoft Office 365, Sophos Antivirus Software, Adobe Creative Cloud, Inspiration and other class required software).
- Reliable and unimpeded access to the ICT resources needed to participate in the learning program of the school.
